Member since 1997, when we got our first (and still only) Beardie.

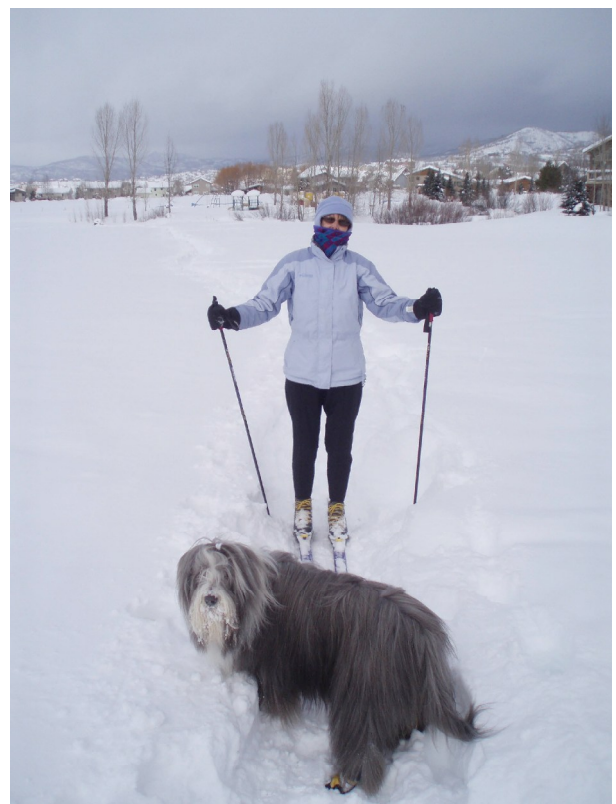
Previously served as RMBC Secretary.
